Shoots and stems are purple/red with curled pinky red leaves.

Shoots and are green with purple speckles. Leaves become heart shaped and turn green. Stems are virilant, growing upwards of six feet, cream /white flowers appear late summer/autumn.

Stems change to dark brown and are hollow, brittle and absent of leaves or flowers.

SPRING: Mar - Apr

SUMMER: May - Aug

AUTUMN: Sept - Oct

WINTER: Nov - Feb
